

# History of The Ranch



Rich History

Saguaro Lake Guest Ranch was created out of the work camp built in 1927 to facilitate the construction of Stewart Mountain Dam between 1928 and 1930. The main lodge functioned as the mess hall, ice house, and commissary for the construction crew. The workers lived in cabins lining the roadway to the new dam. The dam is the last in a chain of four reservoirs that provide flood control and irrigation to the Phoenix Valley.

From Work Camp to Fishing Lodge
When the dam was completed, Phil and Marie Lewis from Kansas purchased the work camp from Salt River Project, and negotiated a concessionaire permit from the U.S. Forest Service and Department of Interior to provide services to the public. The first marina was built on the east side of the dam and the work camp was turned into a fishing resort with a general store, gas station, restaurant, and overnight cabin rentals. Phil and Marie added the touches that still give Saguaro Lake Ranch its charm today. The native river rock walls and fireplaces were built by several local artisans, originally from Mexico. Heavy reinforcing steel from the dam was used for curtain rods, and indoor plumbing was added. Western motif Monterey oak furniture was purchased for the rooms and remains today as a timely reminder of that period.

From Fishing Lodge to Arizona Guest Ranch

Although the ranch started out commercially as a fishing lodge, it soon became a popular guest ranch by offering an Arizona 'destination vacation' for tourists from across the country. The attractions it offered back then differ little from those that still draw quests today: the scenic beauty of the quiet rural setting, the fine winter climate, and the western ranch atmosphere, as well as the variety of outdoor recreation opportunities in the Salt River Recreation Area and

the Tonto National Forest. Today the ranch is still owned by the Durand family that bought the property from the Lewis's in 1948. Three generations have managed the ranch - John and Dottie Kissinger, Steve and Susan Durand, and sons Justin and Kevin Durand.



# Deposits & Payment Schedule

#### Deposits & Payments are required in the following manner:

- \$1,500 deposit to be applied to the site fee at the time of booking.
  - \$500 non-refundable processing fee
  - \$1000 non-refundable 31 days after booking.
- 180 days (6 months) prior to event: 2nd Deposit is due (non-refundable) \*see agreement for details.
- 90 days (3 months) prior to event: 3rd Deposit is due (non-refundable) \*see agreement for details
- 29 days prior to event: Remainder of Add On's & Beverage Packages is due. (non-refundable)
  - Final guest count for rehearsal dinner, reception and Saturday lunch count is required at this time.
- **5 days prior to event:** All cabins will be charged. This allows our staff to focus on you & your guests needs and be available to assist you better.

\*\* The Site Fee and Beverage Package pricing in this agreement reflects a 3% Cash Discount. Cash, Checks & Wire Transfers are acceptable as payment for the site fee and beverage packages. Any other forms of payment such as Credit Cards are also acceptable, however a 3% processing fee will apply.

# Wedding Reception Catering (not included)

Saguaro Lake Guest Ranch is <u>currently unavailable to cater your Wedding Reception</u>, however can provide rehearsal dinner catering on Friday night (Cowboy Cookout) and meals throughout the weekend.

You are welcome to bring in a licensed & certified Caterer or food truck of choice for your wedding reception. (no extra fee) When you bring in an outside caterer, you or your caterer is responsible for procuring the appropriate china, flatware, glassware and servers and bussers for the full duration of the event as SLR does not provide this when you use an outside caterer.

### Music & Entertainment (not included)

We allow you to bring in a live band or DJ entertainment for your event. The lower lawn has plenty of power to supply your entertainment. All amplified music must be turned off by 11PM.

### Tents & Heaters (not included)

Due to the nature of our outdoor venue Tents are suggested as a rain back-up. Some locations prohibit any staking in the ground.

Pre-Approved Freestanding outdoor heaters are allowed on the lawn, however please note

NO LIVE FLAME candles or sparklers may be used! Only LED lights and/or candles are allowed on tables or as decor.

# Dance Floor & Additional Lighting (not included)

The Lower Lawn has some lighting in the trees however, we recommend procuring additional bistro lighting for your reception. You are also welcome to bring in a dance floor. Please note the dance floor may only be on the grass for a total of 24 Hours. This is to help keep the grass preserved for other weddings & events.
